Service Component	Explanation
Collection and Storage	
Collection and transportation of the deceased	Collection and transport of the deceased. Service is usually provided by a funeral director and may be not applicable.
Storage	Storage of the deceased in mortuary or holding room

Administrative Validation of the Death Certificate and associated approvals	Validating receipt of the death certificate, practitioner risk advice and any other documentation provided by a funeral director in order to facilitate the cremation process.

Preparation	General preparation activities for cremation
Cremation	Cremation of human remains
Urn, or vessel for cremated human remains	Storage for return of cremated human remains (if applicable)
Religious, cultural, or spiritual (if applicable)	
Religious, cultural, or spiritual Requirement	Detail of the specific requirements such as witness insertion to cremator (usually an option only and not included in total price unless chosen).
Collection after cremation	
Processing of the cremated human remains for collection	Getting the cremated ashes ready to be collected. The collection service of the cremated remains may be done by the funeral director
Additional Services or Product Fees	
Any items or components of a package that are not included in the above sections	Each product should be clearly itemised and details provided. Eg Cremation levy (if applicable), provision of cremation capsule/casket

If a component is not relevant, it can be marked n/a. Funeral directors who also operate crematoria should also refer to the Fair Trading Funeral information Standard price list template.
